1. Go to TIME MACHINE

3. Click on the push icon “button” on the lower right of your screen.
4. Scroll and click on ALBUM OF TOURNAMENTS AND PARADES IN NUREMBURG”
5. Read about it
6. Read discover hover your mouse over the words with a yellow background read the definition. and Click on “want to know more” read
7. Read IMAGINE click on “through the book”
8. Read CREATE Do the project.
9. Main project, scroll down to family guide and click on the PDF (the pages take a minute to come up). Read and follow along and design your own set of Armor.
