Play at home:

Encourage play! We love playdough, instruments, and building.

Play dough recipe:

2 cups of flour

2 TBS of cream of tartar

½ cup salt

2 cups water

2 TBS Oil

Food coloring

1. Mix dry ingredients in a pot. Mix wet ingredients and food coloring together.
2. Heat on medium while gradually adding the wet ingredients. Cook and stir until a ball forms, about 5 minutes.
3. Cool, kneed, and then store.

We like to use rolling pins, cookie cutters, and other kitchen utensils like potato mashers, spoons, muffin trays etc.

Homemade instruments:

Pots and pans are always fun, but there are more things that you can make too. Try a drum from an empty oatmeal or coffee container. Put rice, beans, or small pasta in a plastic egg. Turn an empty tissue box into a guitar with rubber bands! Use your instruments as you march around and count to 20!

Building:

We have been talking about roads! Make a road out of paper. Cut paper into curves and straights and build a town. Use doll houses as buildings, or any type of boxes can be transformed too. Use crayons, markers, tape and any other art supplies you may have to build with.

Talk about stop and go as you drive cars, and how to cross a road.
