Unit- Water

Reading- Any book is always good and children love reading stories. If you want to read and correlate a story with the water unit, pick books that have weather related stories, rivers, oceans, lakes or even books about feeding animals. Ask open ended questions such as, "Why did the farmer feed the animals fresh water?"

Math- Roll some dice and have them draw that many rain drops. You can also make color patterns with house hold items such as buttons. Red, yellow, blue, red yellow, blue, etc.

Blocks/Legos- Suggest something for your child to build. Example, the horse they saw on television. Can you build a barn for a horse to go in? Make sure there is a roof so rain doesn't get in!

Dress Up/Dramatic Play/Kitchen- They can pretend that they work somewhere, have them play restaurant, take care of a family, play school.

Science- Put a cup outside and catch rain. Keep track of the weather-Sunny, cloudy, rainy, windy, snowy, etc.

Writing- Have your child write their name using chalk, crayons, markers, pencils. Practice holding a pencil. If you have magnetic letters at home they can also use those to make their names. At a grocery store you can find things that has the same letters in their names.

Playdough- Make something together! They can even make their names.

Jobs- Give your child a specific job to do each day and hold them accountable! Example-Help set the table, blanket folder, organizer. They are only 4 and 5 but they are so capable! It makes them feel good about themselves as well.

Social/Emotional- We practice in our class on working on our feelings and how to say nice things to each other. This is something that we can do anywhere! As you know it starts at home!
